### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA

Enclosed is an application for the Criminal Justice Scholarship Program sponsored by the Judges and Police Executives Conference of Erie County, New York.

### <u>Criteria</u>

- Applicant must be a resident of Erie County, New York.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher at the time of graduation.
- Must have 90% or higher attendance rate at time of graduation.
- Applicant must be accepted and entering into a Criminal Justice or Qualified 2 or 4-year Degree Legal Program within Erie County, NY.

#### OR

- Applicant may be an undergraduate student who graduates in 2020 and has a GPA of 3.5 or higher and has been accepted and is entering into SUNY at Buffalo Law School.
- Applicant <u>must</u> submit an <u>application and 500-word scholarship essay</u>\*.
- Applicant <u>must</u> submit Two (2) <u>letters of recommendation from faculty members (Teachers</u> who the applicant was a student of) or One (1) from a faculty member and One (1) from an employer and or community service director for which the applicant is a member of.
- Applicant must be available for a personal interview by the Scholarship Awards Committee if so requested.
- Application must be received by the committee no later than May 1, 2020.
